Dear Mr. Bentley,

I am writing to you and to Ontario Premier Dalton McGuinty – as well as the local Municipal Council of Tiny Township, County Simcoe – to make you aware of my strenuous objections to a proposed “**Strategic Plan**” in **Tiny Township**. This Plan has been formulated largely behind closed doors, without wider community input. Vote date for the Plan is November 14, 2008.

I am a member of the newly formed Ardmere Beach Community Association in Tiny Township, which has come into existence in opposition to this proposed Municipal Strategic Plan - because we understand that almost **200 years of historical public use** of our area’s beaches will be seriously threatened with passage of this piece of municipal legislation. It is significant because it sets a precedent for beach privatization throughout the province.

Along with this letter, I am including my letter to the Premier on this matter. I urge you to read this letter personally and investigate the circumstances described in it that are taking place in Tiny Township at this time. These are very serious matters, which involve upholding the laws of Ontario and protecting the historical rights of its citizens.

I do believe the actions of what can only be described as a rogue Township Council – in league with beach privatization initiatives (by local water-facing owners) that are in themselves abuses of the Ontario Boundaries Act – fall under the jurisdiction of your office and its fiduciary responsibility **to all the citizens of Ontario**.
